



REGULATION OF WOLFRAM RESEARCH AWARDS FOR THE YOUNG RESEARCHER BEST PAPER

1. Two Full 1 year Mathematica licenses + Mathematica Online and Two 1 year subscription to Wolfram|Alpha Pro, will constitute the Wolfram Research Award to distinguish the best papers presented at the Conference written by young researchers. Researchers can apply up to 40 years of age in 31/12/2020 or researchers who have obtained a PhD for less than 10 years in 31/12/2020.
2. Researchers who wish to apply for the Award must submit, along with the paper, a statement of honor that they are in the preceding paragraph conditions and a note, not exceeding one A4 page, summarizing the reasons they judge their work worth of distinction.
3. The Jury is chaired by Professor Carlos A. Mota Soares, Professor Emeritus of the University of Lisbon
4. The Jury will award two WOLFRAM RESEARCH prizes.
5. The Jury is sovereign in the decisions taken and it may seek clarification and advice about the works presented, to whom it better considers.
6. The Jury reserves the right not to award any prize if it considers that none of the papers presented meets the minimum quality requirements.
7. If the winning work has more than one author, the prize will be to the first author.
8. The winners will be announced and their prizes delivered during the conference dinner.
